Competition rules

The competition is primarily aimed at schools and individual young people in Walsall and the surrounding districts.

The competition will be open to Primary and Secondary schools, SMH schools and individual young persons whose ages fall between 7-11; 12-13; 14-16 and 16-18 years of age.

The entries will be restricted to 2D works ie. drawings and/or paintings, but the subjects and media are open.

The size of the art work must be no greater than A2.



Entrants may submit 1 or 2 pieces of work.

A label showing the entrant's name, age, school and title of the work, must be affixed to the back of each artwork.
